




### « One Sustainable Health »

**ONE HEALTH** is an integrated, unifying approach that aims to sustainably balance and optimize the health of people, animals and ecosystems.

It recognizes the health of humans, domestic and wild animals, plants, and the wider environment (including ecosystems) are closely linked and inter-dependent.




The approach mobilizes multiple sectors, disciplines and communities at varying levels of society to work together to foster wellbeing and tackle threats to health and ecosystems, while addressing the collective need for clean water, energy and air, safe and nutritious food, taking action on climate change, and contributing to sustainable development.

## Organization







To mitigate existing "silos" through interdisciplinary and multisectoral discussions and address priorities in the field in a consistent manner by working in complementarity with existing organisations, initiatives and projects.



To make operational recommendations that will be integrated into a *One Sustainable Health Declaration*, to be published in March 2023 in Lyon. The *OSH Declaration* will provide guidelines for operational programs and public policies for stakeholders involved in the field.



## The 7 International Working Groups themes



#### • Independence

Members of the IWGs shall participate as individuals and not as representatives of their institutions. They will be required to disclose any interest that may conflict with their commitment in the OSH Forum or that may have an impact on the discussions.

#### « Chatham House rules »

In order to encourage open dialogue, Chatham House rules will apply to all discussions held within the IWGs. No paper, or report, or declaration shall reveal or assign expressed opinions or ideas to an identified participant.

• Focus on operational recommendations & implementation IWGs are expected to propose operational outputs on the five set of deliverables identified in the next slide. Their thematic discussions will also directly feed the « 6+1 » discussions and global vision to be presented in the OSH Declaration.



## International Working Group deliverables

The One Sustainable Health Declaration will be a joint publication between all the individuals and organisations that are members of the OSH Forum. IWG 6+1 will have

the task to synthesize the recommendations made by each group within one, transdisciplinary and collaborative manifesto. The recommendations made by each group must consider the following five deliverables:



## OSH Forum

On October 26th, 2020 at the French embassy in Berlin, a pledge for the cooperative development of the OSH Forum was signed between the One Sustainable Health for All Foundation and the World Health Summit. This forum is to include all stakeholders in order to facilitate the operational implementation of the One Sustainable Health approach through innovative projects.

OSH Forum is part of the movement towards an integrated, borderless approach to One Health. 
