





### Secretariat

### What could be a PREZODE label?

 A way to indicate a willingness to contribute to the global effort for zoonotic disease prevention

 A way to show that we are operationnally working together on the prevention of zoonotic disease emergence

 A way to foster synergies between activities through active cooperation, collaboration and communication



#### What to be labelled?

- LARGE FUNDING PROGRAMS which are also promoting integrated health approach for the prevention of emerging risks
  - Could co-fund projects or activities with PREZODE
  - Projects funded under a PREZODE labelled program will be PREZODE labelled

#### PROJECTS

- Research projects
- Research and development projects
- Development projects
- Training programs/curricula



## Why labeling funded programmes or projects?

- Access to a large network and opportunity to create new collaboration and synergies
- Access to a knowledge platform and tools
- Visibility for the thematic and for the activities



## How the labeling could work?

 Identification of criteria based on PREZODE scientific postulates and values: is the project or programme meets PREZODE basic principles and values?

 No assessment of the scientific excellence – Programmes will keep their autonomy and independance

Process through the Steering Committee with external reviewers
